



Look at what VALUE(S) could help our society. Afterwards, pick your TOPIC, and look at the different subjects you can use to connect your ideas.

As you begin to research, you can ask yourself, "What UNIVERSAL THEMES does my project address?

OR

Look at the UNIVERSAL THEMES. What interests you? What TOPIC would show this theme well? Pick a topic and begin to research and see what subjects connect with it well. Then as you work, look at what VALUE(S) your project could have for our society.

OR

Select a TOPIC, something that really interests you. Look at the VALUE(S) that this topic may have. As you research your topic, find out what other subjects you can connect to it. Then look at the UNIVERSAL THEMES. Which one works with your project?

You may find other ways that work well for you and/or your group. Do what works best for you!!!!
